



RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING SOKOL CAMP

Sokol Children's Camp is owned and maintained by Gymnastic Association Sokol, St. Louis, Missouri. The facility was built primarily for use by members of the organization. The Camp Committee, whose members are duly appointed by the organization, is responsible for the maintenance and operation of the camp. Expelled and delinquent members are considered non-members.

RIGHTS OF MEMBERS

1. All adult members in good standing have free access to the camp at all times, except on restricted days, such as Children's Camping. When access to any locked building, the swimming pool or any other facility is desired, the member should contact a Camp Committee member to obtain a key or identify himself by displaying his membership card to the caretaker for admittance.
2. Each member has the privilege of bringing five visitors at any one time. Approval at a regular Sokol meeting is required for more than five visitors per member. Non-members must be accompanied by a member who is responsible for ensuring non-member fees are paid. This fee is payable to the Caretaker or a Camp Committee member or Drop Box at the time of the visit. The fee is \$5 for 18 years and up and \$3 for 5-17 years and 4 and under is free. Children and teens (including youth members) must be accompanied by an adult member at all times.
3. Every member has the privilege of using the kitchen except on restricted days. Cleanup and securing the property is the member's responsibility.
4. Adult Members (21 and up) are permitted to stay overnight except during restricted periods. There is a fee for every non-member adult and child 5 years of age or older for each night spent at camp. Any member wishing to spend a few days at camp shall report his intentions to the Camp Committee as far in advance as possible.
5. Out-of-state Sokol members in good standing are the guests of Sokol St. Louis and are not required to pay visitors fees.

REQUIREMENTS OF MEMBERS

1. All members and visitors are to act in a responsible manner.
2. Members should make every attempt to conserve gas, electric, and water.

3. Care of equipment, building, and grounds is the responsibility of each member.
4. Members are responsible for any visitor brought to Camp.
5. Children using the pool are to be supervised by an adult member.

REGULATIONS

1. No firearms or fireworks are permitted at any time except by special permission of the Camp Committee.
2. Smoking is not permitted in the main lodge at any time.
3. Pets are not permitted.
4. Profane language, hazardous games, drunkenness, or violent disturbances will not be tolerated.
5. Neither food nor beverages may be brought to Camp whenever same is being sold, such as picnic days.
6. Trash shall be put in containers and may not be burned without the approval of the Camp Committee.
7. Reproduction of any key for access to the facilities is prohibited.
8. Use of machinery is the responsibility of the Camp Committee.
